ANNUAL STATISTICAL REPORT SCHOOL ADMISSION, TRANSPORT AND EXCLUSION APPEALS SEPTEMBER 2020 TO AUGUST 2021 SCHOOL ADMISSION APPEALS

Applicants can lodge appeals for any school they have not been awarded a place in, but not all such appeals reach the stage of being heard by an appeals panel. This is because either a place is offered at their preferred school, or parents withdraw their appeal. The heard rate is therefore a better measure of the appeal rate.

The statistics in this report include statutory appeals for Community and Voluntary Controlled schools, plus Academies, Free, Voluntary-aided and Foundation schools for whom Customer Service provide a clerking service.

An Independent Appeal Panel's decision to uphold an appeal will fall into one of the following:

- **Upheld 1**: The case was NOT proved that to admit more children would "prejudice efficient education or the efficient use of resources" at the school:
- **Upheld 2**: The circumstances of the parental case were so exceptional as to outweigh the "prejudice" to the school;
- **Upheld A**: That the child would have been offered a place if the school admission arrangements had been properly implemented and/or did not breach the mandatory provisions of the School Admissions Code and SSFA 1998;
- **Upheld B**: The decision to refuse admission was NOT one which a reasonable admission authority would have made in the circumstances of the case.

Admission appeals for school year 2021/22 - Primary Reception and Secondary Transfer.

Secondary transfer appeals administered by Customer Service for the 2021/22 school year, heard in the summer term 2021, were 9.9% down on those for secondary transfer 2020/21. The actual difference was a decrease of 49 appeals.

Primary Reception appeals administered by Customer Service for the 2021/22 school year, heard in the summer term 2021, were 27.1% down on those for primary reception 2020/21. The actual difference was a decrease of 45 appeals.

7. HOME TO SCHOOL TRANSPORT APPEALS Appeals for free home to school transport – all schools and academies

The home to school travel and transport statutory guidance, issued by the Department for Education in July 2014, introduced a structured two stage review process allowing parents to challenge decisions taken by the local authority in relation to home to school transport. Stage One ensures a review of the parent's application by a panel of senior officers and Stage Two allows the parent to request a review by an independent appeal panel. The figures below show the number of parents that progressed their application to an independent panel and the outcomes.

8. SCHOOL EXCLUSION REVIEWS - All School types

Following a review there are three options open to the panel: to uphold the decision to exclude; recommend that the governing body reconsiders its decision, or quash the decision and direct that the governing body considers the exclusion again. The final option imposes a £4,000 fine if the governing body does not offer to reinstate the pupil within 10 days of being notified of the review panel's decision.

In 2020/21 there were 10 applications for review lodged by parents against the permanent exclusion of their child from a Hertfordshire school/academy. In two cases, the panel decided to uphold the decision to exclude, in five cases, the panel concluded that the decision to exclude the pupil was so flawed that they quashed the decision and directed that the governing body consider the exclusion again. In one case, the panel found there to be procedural improprieties which had had a significant impact on the quality of the decision-making process. Therefore, the panel recommended in this case that the governing body reconsider their decision. *At time of going to press, one review is still to be heard.
