1. Tailoring

• Listen more to what you and your family needs.



 Create plans for young people that focus on what they can achieve.

 You know what services are around who can help.



2. Enabling

We will make sure that the people who help you have all the learning they need.



How we will do this:

- Make sure that all professionals listen to you.
- Make sure that your needs are always the most important thing.



 Make sure that all professionals and families get the training they need.




This will mean that:

3. Provision


We will make sure that there is the right support for you in your local area.

How we will do this:

 Make sure you can have one assessment for support and then get help from all the services you need.

 Make sure there is good support for your mental health.






This is your SEN Officer calling to tell you about your child's Education, Health and Care Plan.
